TransHumanism (TH): What is it?

Is the movement to use technology (mainly in the areas of life sciences, alternative energies, and computer science) to challenge biological limitations and eventually find solutions to such limitations. This is often linked with the idea that science and technology can be used to continually improve the human condition - called 'progress'.

Examples of TH include Artificial Intelligence, cryogenics, space colonization, cloning, medical implants, cyborgs, cognitive enhancement, life extension, transcending our mortality, the death of death, defect elimination (form of eugenics) and so on. With its current momentum, TH will directly impact your grandchildren before 2030.

TH: Where do we see it? - the Singularity

Within thirty years, we will have the technological means to create superhuman intelligence. Shortly after, the human era will be ended. This is what I call the singularity. It is a point where our present models must be discarded and a new reality takes over. As we move closer and closer to this point, it will loom vaster and vaster over human affairs till the notion becomes a commonplace. Yet when it finally happens it may still be a great surprise and a greater unknown even if still unrecognized by most. (Victor Vinge Marooned in Real Time 1986 - adapted PW).

When humans transcend their biology (Ray Kurzweil) and in our grandchildren's lifetime!

TH: How does it work? - AI

A *progress trap* is a type of 'catch 22' whereby new technology that could improve life for a few of us but that ends up making things worse for all of us due to a failure to manage risks and unintended consequences, as well as needing to use more of the technology to solve the problems the technology caused in the first place.

So is AI, which TH relies on, silently taking over the world one washing machine at a time the *progress trap* to end all progress traps? Elon Musk is quite eloquent on this and quite worried as well. Is AI then the ultimate *progress trap*. Imagine ISIS terrorists getting hold of AI? Or Kim Jong Un?

Key TH technologies inc. (1) artificial intelligence, (2) robotics, (3) genetic engineering, & (4) nano-tech.

We need to preserve Nature as the visible shape of humanness, as a reference for feeling and awe, and crucially as the gestalt of our own psyche. Without Nature, we risk losing important parts ourselves, our identity and ultimately our humanity. Thus, we risk losing our ability to love.



Today most people in the environment movement (and other church denominations) do not understand that AI is a real threat to humans and the effects will impact us *well before* the longer term climate effects like sea level rise which will, most likely, be more gradual. Earth's natural feedback mechanisms are buffering and delaying some of the climate change.

AI and its associated technology does not have such feedback unless humans rebel against technology and I don't see much evidence of this yet. We've never before seen such a massive converging of technologies like this & the key difference is its intelligence, efficiency and autonomy.

If you look at the impact of technology in our lifetimes and the current rate of change, AI in its many subtle guises is happening now and I expect it will, in the next 100 months, accelerate and impact us like a Tsunami such that we will have no ethical bearings. And most importantly no understanding of 'what it is to be fully human before the elite become trans-human with life extension.

What then is our UU Logic Base?→ How do we become fully human using this logic base? So what would a UU drone, UU robotic kitchen, or **UU** intentional community, look & act like?



God(dess) as the Ground of our being

- Intriguingly Spong describes this *post-christian god as 'the ground of our being*' very Wiccan/pagan/indigenous.
- This Ground is where we draw spiritual sustenance and meaning.
- But this Ground is shifting.....

God(dess) as the Ground of our being

Q: So when we look at our Grandchildren and ask *what is the ground of their being* and thus their becoming? Where do they spend most of their time?

A: Social Media. This is where they will draw their sense of being. Not from F2F Family and Friends and Fellowship rather uncritically F2S i.e. technologically mediated communication on Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat and so forth

All these are technological platforms that predispose our children to embracing a techno-utopian world view.

God(dess) as the Ground of our being

- So today *technology has become the ground of our and our children's being*. It amplifies the impact of any decision, good or bad.
- With the gap between technology and social change (inc. human ethics) widening exponentially, the chances for catastrophic consequences also increases exponentially.
- So our *UU Logic Base* becomes vital and is like the finger pointing towards the moon/fully human. As members of UU we need to seek to follow where our collective finger is pointing. And then action it.

- In Christian terms, for me, this is what Jesus meant by the *Kingdom of Heaven* Is this up up and away? Or as I prefer to say the *Practical governance of our Spiritual Commonwealth* i.e. in our day to day world thus my interest in Sociocracy.
- Rather than the Kingdom of God being *a pie in the sky that we can get bye and bye* we have 'our ground of being' where we can *get it on the ground while we're still around*.
- This is where the UU logic base comes in again. I reckon its a great underpinning for out-, and in-, reaching our *Spiritual Commonwealth* as a counterpoint to TransHumanism

Here the question of *Governance* is about the very nature of 'heaven's' domain, i.e. the rule or governance of human life in order to make it harmonise with the purpose of its giver. Thus the whole enterprise could be compared to a vineyard/Nature that needs tending and cultivation in ways that would have encouraged it, and us, to yield what we are meant to yield/do/be.

What then is this human contract as part of the Governance of Heaven? Whilst Earth natives, we are living on land we did not create and are consuming resources that we did not lay by. We are demonstrably careless not only of the welfare of our fellow human beings here and now but of generations to come, and of our host planet. We are careless in the governance (collectively expressed care/caritas) of the Earth and her cargo.








THE "SUCCESS" OF OUR SPECIES: POPULATION GROWTH


If our population and our command over the resources of the planet are any indication, we have become the most successful species on the planet.



THE "SUCCESS" OF OUR SPECIES: HUMAN APPROPRIATED of NET PRIMARY PRODUCTION

This is an indication of how much of nature our species has appropriated for our own (human) purposes. Depending on the measurement method, recent estimates range from 19% to 40% (<u>Harberl et al, 2013</u>; <u>U of Mich</u>)

Net primary production is the rate at which all the plants in an ecosystem produce net useful chemical energy; it is equal to the difference between the rate at which the plants in an ecosystem produce useful chemical energy (GPP) and the rate at which they use some of that energy during respiration. *Our Human Footprint/Foodprint*



Human Appropriation of Net Primary Production (percent of local NPP)

Transhumanism Play I: What we are seeking to understand Transhumanism play as a vital component of children's play within the context of David Feldman's 1994*, Non-universal theory of child and cognitive development. Here learning is associated cognitive domain related rather than universal age-cohort related.

This means the child is encouraged to conceptualise, design, fabricate and then play with individually or in a group, using bric-a-brac on hand at the time – subsequently this process can be repeated using the same materials after it has been disassembled.

What we are trying not to do is to have the child play with toys!!! And especially those that require instructions and especially instructions that need to be read to the child that is we are seeking to avoid colouring between the lines so to speak metaphorically that is.



Transhumanism Play III: Bricolage is two tools in one 1 for analysis and 1 for synthesis AAA – the Transhumanism/hermeneutic learning circle so to speak.

Tool in the sense of *Techneque* (tool as extension of the human) rather than *Technique* (human as extension of the tool) an absolutely crucial nuance With the Logic Base as outlined below

So a pedagogy that sits behind BL will need to be chiro-focused, play lensed and domain oriented rather than universalist.

This process can be seen in the following analogue: Non-universal theory of Child development is a theory of <u>cognitive development</u> first created in 1994 by David Henry Feldman, a professor at the Eliot-Pearson School of Child Development at Tufts University. The theory proposes that development occurs in <u>domain-specific</u> relatively discrete stages or zones (versus the universal stages of temporal child development of Piaget etc.).

Domain-specific learning theories of development hold that we have several independent, specialised knowledge structures, rather than one cohesive knowledge structure. Thus, training in one domain may not impact another independent domain.

For example, domain knowledge theorists believe people have highly specialised functions that are relatively independent of one another. Jean Piaget's theory of development, otoh, believed that knowledge is internalised into a cohesive knowledge structure, favouring the universal learning mode. The transition of one stage to the next is one of the core concepts of the theory. In it, development begins with the consolidation of a skill set for a particular stage. Outlying or satellite skills are then brought closer together through integration and intervolvement of advanced skills with development of retarded skills.

The next step is *elaboration*, where new skills are added. This is followed by a period of *incubation*, followed by a phase in which a *novel* intergraded/intervolved skill set emerges which is more advanced than the others. This novel skill then pulls the other skills along with it in a phase called *reversion* leading to accretion i.e. pentimento. Then the process repeats itself with another stage of *consolidation*. This continues until the learner reaches the *master* level.



Healing our Ancestral Divide

Jung said, "our whole evolutionary background has not yet caught up" (p. 236) with us, in fact "We are very far from having finished completely with the middle ages, classical antiquity, and primitivity i.e. the archaic, as our modern psyches pretend we have" (p. 236). This ever widening gap between us and our ancestors is deeply concerning. Because we haven't been paying attention to our ancestors and consciously integrating them into our lives, their experiences have become a "denied expression in life and therefore coalesce into a relatively autonomous 'splinter personality' with contrary tendencies in the unconscious" (Jung, 1983, p.442); they have in essence become a shadow aspect of who we are as individuals and as a collective.

Whether we realise it or not, we all are carrying our ancestors within us. Their hopes, dreams, fears and unanswered questions loom around us in the depths of our psyche and run through our very blood as it once did theirs. The disconnection between us and our direct lineages has created a wide gap, one in which our ancestors try to mend through activation of certain complexes and great stirrings in our shadow. This can cause enormous confusion to the person experiencing their ancestor's shadows and complexes arising as their own or their own complexes and shadow being activated by their ancestors. Through bringing in this awareness however, we can explore conscious and creative ways to integrate these aspects into the Self which will not only help us to become more understanding of our own personal process, but can also lead to individuation. Welcome to our archaic ancestors.....

The Philosophical Transhumanism - The:

- Methodological Transhumanism is adept at performing a large number of diverse tasks, ranging from interviewing to intensive self-reflection and introspection.

- Theoretical Transhumanism reads widely and is knowledgeable about the many interpretive paradigms that can be brought to any particular problem.

- Researcher as Transhumanism-theorist/practitioner works between and within competing and overlapping perspectives and paradigms.

- Interpretive Transhumanism understands that research is an interactive process shaped by his or her own personal history, biography, gender, social class, race, and ethnicity, and by those of the people in the setting.

- Critical Transhumanism stresses the dialectical and hermeneutic nature of interdisciplinary inquiry, knowing that the boundaries that previously separated traditional disciplines no longer hold.

- Political Transhumanism knows that science is power, for all research findings have political implications. There is no value-free science.

- Narrative Transhumanism also knows that researchers all tell stories about the worlds they have studied. Thus the narratives, or stories, scientists tell are accounts couched and framed within specific storytelling traditions, often defined as paradigms.

- Product of the interpretive Transhumanism's labour is a complex, quilt-like bricolage, a reflexive collage or montage - a set of fluid, interconnected images and representations. This interpretive structure is like a quilt, a performance text, a sequence of representations connecting the parts to the whole.

Manifesto: Towards a PB Logic Base

[A] <u>Principles</u> of PB:

1. <u>Four elements in designing</u> a PB Project (practical wisdom, right intention, creative synthesis, efficacious extension), 2. <u>Four processes in undertaking</u> a PB project in any of these four elements: (PB (applying the six principles of Bricolage (see below), AR (Archaic Renaissance), DP (Direct Participation) & DE (Deep Empathy)).

[B] <u>Attributes</u> of PB - A PB project commits to these attributes:

1. Learning by doing: in education - the curriculum from the lived life of the student, 2. Blending Agency with dexterity, 3 A recognition that 'hand-made head' i.e. 'chiro generated cogno' and 'hands not heads first', 4. Incorporates robust functionality and Simplexity over complexity, 5. A focus on Techneque before Technique (see f/n⁴&⁵ below), 6. DIO Resilience esp. for youth inc. young men, 7. Participatory governance - Deep Participation and collaboration (DP) of many to many, 8. Evolvable sustainability - through practical creativity, community economy and harmonisation of diversity not centralisation of conformity, 9. - Here we see the archaic parallel of three intervolved daily handy activities fire, and making, & using basic tools with the socialisation & the haptic tactility with dexterous agency there-of/with/from e.g. shed/kitchen/garden/camping activities.
- Here I submit we need to invert the view we have of ourselves from one of head to hand without heart, to one of hand to heart to head. In a sense we need to see ourselves more than Enlightenment beings all head with the rest basically left off or withering completely with infusions of human or computer slave/AI, to a Renaissance being that values craft as a two-way expression of us and our hands.
- For example the majority of Cephalopod's (Octopus) 500m neurons (about the same as a dogs or a two year old child) are in their equivalent of hands so that these 'brainy ∞ arms' can touch, taste, smell and even see (via. camouflage skin colour changes). Further they show playful; mischief and craft' with their hands as a key characteristic of octopus intelligence. So Octopi actually think and play with their hands and fingers (and suckers!!). In a crucial sense this is what I am saying is being lost in humans. Another take on the Western Cartesian 'either-or' dualistic 'mind-or-body' thematic. Transhumanism Play

A Transhumanism slant to children's play – so this means the child is encouraged to conceptualise, design, fabricate and then play with individually or in a group, using bric-a-brac on hand at the time – subsequently this process can be repeated using the same materials after it has been disassembled.

What we are trying not to do is to have the child play with toys!!! And especially those that require instructions and especially instructions that need to be read to the child that is we are seeking to avoid colouring between the lines so to speak metaphorically that is.

Transhumanism play is play that :

Play that engages the definition of the Transhumanism:

What then is Bricolage? (B from French means 'tinkerer') is about the design and use of local/indigenous human ingenuity in a 'crafty' construction made of whatever materials are at hand; something created from a variety of available things – a Jack or Jill of all trades and master of some!!

A person/craftsperson/design/play system who/which actions a *logic base (following slide)* that is comfortable with unfamiliar realms and emergent situations and who is prepared to try/mix'n'match various options out, using *safe-fail rather than fail-safe*, until a suitable design emerges, such a form of praxis includes design, fabrication & use of both the Project, & the tools for the job at hand.

Bricolage is two tools in one 1 for analysis and 1 for synthesis AAA – the Transhumanism/hermeneutic learning circle so to speak. This means the box of stuff we spoke about will need to include 'stuff' that can be pulled to bits and put back together differently e.g. Velcro

Tool in the sense of *Techneque* (tool as extension of the human) rather than *Technique* (human as extension of the tool) an absolutely crucial nuance
